

TRUCK-MOUNTED ATTENUATORS FOR MOVING OPERATIONS

- xx. DESCRIPTION. This work shall consist of furnishing, operating, and supervising the use of truck-mounted attenuators for moving operations for the performance of work as shown in the Plans or as directed by the Engineer.

The work under this Section shall be performed in accordance with these provisions and Section 608 of the Standard Specifications.

- xx. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS.

- (a) Truck-Mounted Attenuator, AWV/FPV. Truck-Mounted Attenuator, AWV/FPV shall consist of a Truck-Mounted Attenuator meeting the requirements of Subsection 608.02(h) and equipped with a Changeable Message Sign in accordance with the MUTCD. The equipment shall be mounted so as to be clearly visible to the traveling public and shall be capable of being controlled from inside the cab of the vehicle, with capable controls including but not limited to turning the sign on and off, changing between preset messages, and inserting new messages when approved by the Engineer. Phases of signing shall automatically change.
- (b) Truck-Mounted Attenuator, Protection Vehicle. Truck-Mounted Attenuator, Protection Vehicle shall consist of a Truck-Mounted Attenuator meeting the requirements of Subsection 608.02(h) and equipped with an Arrow Board in accordance with the MUTCD. The equipment shall be mounted so as to be clearly visible to the traveling public.

The Engineer will issue written orders to the Contractor for work to be performed by the specified equipment.

- xx. METHOD OF MEASUREMENT. The quantities of Special Provision (Truck-Mounted Attenuator, AWV/FPV) and Special Provision (Truck-Mounted Attenuator, Protection Vehicle) to be measured for payment will be the number of hours each piece of equipment was in operation on the project, including necessary travel time within the project limits.
- xx. BASIS OF PAYMENT. The accepted quantities of Special Provision (Truck-Mounted Attenuator, AWV/FPV) and Special Provision (Truck-Mounted Attenuator, Protection Vehicle) will be paid for at the Contract unit price per hour. Payment will be full compensation for performing the work specified; for furnishing, operating, and supervising the use of this equipment, including fuel, repairs, attachments, and transportation of the equipment to and from the project; and for furnishing all labor, tools, other equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

The Contract unit price for these items shall also include all costs of furnishing the unit on which the attenuator is mounted, solely for the purpose of the attenuator.
