Applications submitted with Vermont motor vehicle registration renewals and/or transfers must be submitted to the Montpelier office by mail or in person (branch offices do not provide these services).

(If this is a new registration or a transfer, form TA-VD-119, Vt. Registration, Tax & Title Application must also be submitted along with the required fees.)

INSTRUCTIONS

Beginning November 11, 1998 the Vermont Commissioner of Motor Vehicles was authorized to issue special motor vehicle license plates to Vermont U.S. veterans, as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(2). These license plates may be issued for use only on vehicles registered at the pleasure car rate of \$60.00 annually (gas) or \$27.00 annually (diesel) or \$104.25 annually (other fuels) or on trucks registered for not more than 8,099 lbs. at the applicable fee.

The additional one-time fee for a veteran's license plate is \$10.00. These license plates will be issued bearing a distinctive number series, therefore, requests for "personalized" or vanity number plates or veterans plate versions of 'low number' plates will not be accepted.

The plates shall be reissued only to the original holder of the plates or the surviving spouse.

Applications for Vermont U.S. Veteran's license plates will be accepted at any time by mail. Applications will be accepted in person "over the counter" at DMV branch offices only for New Registrations or if replacement plates are requested.

Applications submitted with Vermont motor vehicle registration renewals and/or transfers must be submitted to the Montpelier office by mail or in person (branch offices do not provide these services).

Original forms are not required. Faxed copies will be accepted as long as they contain the required certified stamp and authorized signature.

You may submit Section 1 of your application to the Vermont Office of Veterans Affairs for certification as a U. S. Veteran at any time.

Please submit this completed application along with your renewal notice and required fees (if applicable). Please enclose the additional \$10.00 one-time fee for the veteran's plate along with the annual renewal fees or other fees. Mail to the address indicated below. (*If this is a new registration or a transfer of a registration, form TA-VD-119, Vermont Registration, Tax & Title Application must also be submitted.*)

SECTION 1

Please provide all requested personal identification information. Check the box on the bottom left side of Section 1 if application is being made as the surviving spouse of a previous holder of a Vermont Veteran's license plate. If the address indicated is different than our records we will consider this a notification of change of mailing address for all your records.

SECTION 2

When Section 1. has been completed the applicant should mail the form to: **Vermont Office of Veterans Affairs, Drawer 20, 118 State St., Montpelier, VT 05620-4401.**

NOTE: Eligible Vermont veterans who have records maintained at the State of Vermont Military Department will have their applications certified by an original stamp and signature and mailed back to them.

Veterans who have moved to Vermont since discharge from military service should attach copies of their Discharge Record, DD-214, U.S. Veterans Affairs documentation, or other document and mail them to the above address for the certification and return by the Office of Veterans Affairs.

SECTION 3

After the Office of Veterans Affairs has completed Section 2, the applicant should provide the vehicle information requested in Section 3 and submit the signed application with the required \$10 fee to the Department of Motor Vehicles. The renewal notice for the vehicle, Form TA-VD-100 or your Registration Certificate will have the preprinted information required to complete Section 3. Please be sure to read your renewal notice and provide the information and fees requested if also renewing your registration.

Applications submitted without certification by Vermont Office of Veterans Affairs, the signature of the applicant, or the required fee will be returned to the applicant.
